#### 1 Information from the law firm

- Current Bylaws look OK
- President and treasurer can spend 10K without council approval
- Email voting must be unanimous
- Possibility of using electronic voting must be first approved by physical signatures of council members
- Live meetings recommended for important decisions
- No investment memo is needed, advise is to use a trusted investment advisor

#### 2 Information from ICAPS 2026 organizers

- The conference and PC chairs presented information about ICAPS 2026 conference organization:
  - o Dates and location: June 27 July 2, 2026, Dublin
  - Venue: Clayton hotel
  - Standard structure of the program (DC, workshops, main program) with opening reception and social event
    - Four special tracks (apps, human-aware, learning, robotics) with shared PC
    - Discussion of deadlines and reviewing platforms (EasyChair, OpenReview)
    - Submissions December 2 (abstract), December 8 (paper), February 20 (notification)
  - Preliminary idea of conference fee structure and budget about 256K EUR (confirmed sponsors about 17K EUR)
    - Early registration fee 850 EUR, student fee 650 EUR (includes lunches during the whole program)
  - Conference hotel accommodation price is unknown yet
  - Using a professional conference organizer Keynote
  - Collocation with other events not yet decided (TIME, Conference on Diagnosis)
- ICAPS summer school at University College Dublin, June 22-25, 2026
  - Local organizer: Rem Collier
  - o Chairs: Scott Sanner, Siddharth Srivastava
  - Budget is independent from ICAPS (suggestion from council to coordinate budget with the main conference)
- Council provides 15K USD support to support underrepresented communities

### 3 Presentation of ICAPS 2027 proposal

- Dates and location: June 15-20, 2027 (June 10-14 for summer school), Columbia (South Carolina)
  - Big international airports around: Atlanta, Washington DC, Charlotte with flights to Columbia.
- Suggested venue (not yet confirmed): Columbia Metropolitan Convention Center used for main conference and workshops (one block from the university as an alternative location for workshops)
  - o Hotels around the venue available in price range169-229 USD/night
- Assuming University of South Carolina Conference Services to handle registration and logistics
- Expected registration fee: 750 USD (550 USD for students)
- Possible collocations assumed but not yet confirmed (KR, CPAIOR, SOCS)
- Request from organizers to obtain an official letter from ICAPS Inc. confirming organization of the event
  - o possible, but after the conference is officially approved by council
- Request from organizers to help with recruiting sponsorship chairs
  - o some names provided by council members
- Request from Council to provide a more detailed proposal that includes a draft of budget and a contingency plan for travel (visa etc.) issues
- Voting postponed after obtaining a detailed proposal
